The Golf Croquet League will consist of a series of matches played on courts sized from full size to half size. The league will be divided into Division 1 and Division 2

Each team will consist of three players. The composition of the team may vary from match to match. A club may enter more than one team in the League, but players may only play for one team during the season.

Each team will meet each of the other teams in the respective divisions once only each season with about half of the matches being played at home.

The games should be played in a friendly relaxed atmosphere and light refreshments may be appropriate.

League Rules and regulations

1. An entry fee of £2-00 per team is payable to the League to help cover the administrative costs. Cheques should be made payable to 'E M Croquet Association' and sent to the treasurer, **Mr Michael Finnigan, 1 Kirk Hill, East Bridgford, Nottinghamshire, NG13 8PE** using the entry form enclosed.
2. Play will be in accordance with the 'Laws of Golf Croquet' current at the time of the game. Copies of the Laws can be obtained from the Croquet Association or downloaded from the CA web-site.
3. Games will be played as level play. At the end of the match players may adjust their handicap card in accordance with the Laws for level play, see handicap card for details.
4. Members of a team should be ranked in order of strength, i.e. the best player as number 1 etc. Nine single and three doubles games should be played.
The suggested order of play is:-
 - Round 1 1+3 v 1+3, 2 v 2
 - Round 2 2+3 v 2+3, 1 v 1
 - Round 3 1+2 v 1+2, 3 v 3
 - Round 4 1 v 3, 2 v 1, 3 v 2
 - Round 5 3 v 1, 1 v 2, 2 v 3
5. All games are to be played to 13 points. The winner of each game will be the first to reach 7 points.
6. The ending of timed games will be in accordance with the Laws, (Regulation 24-Time Limits) i.e. on the expiry of time play shall continue for a further eight strokes. If the scores are then still level the next hoop in order will be contested to decide the outcome of the game.
Any ball struck before time is called will be deemed to complete its run inside time.
7. The Division winners will be the team winning the most matches. If a tie occurs between two or more teams the order determining the places will be:
 - Who beat whom.
 - Biggest points difference

1st Division

Games should be played on full sized lawns wherever this is possible.

Time limit of 45 minutes per game will apply but where double banking is necessary the time may be extended by joint agreement of the Club captains.

2nd Division

Time limit of 30 minutes per game will apply but where double banking is necessary the time may be extended by joint agreement of the Club captains.
