

Golf Croquet Handicap Trigger Points

Golf croquet players with green handicap cards exchange *Index* points in level play matches and tournaments. As their Index points rise, their Handicap improves (and visa versa) when they hit trigger points.

Example: A H4's index at the end of a level play tournament goes from 1,686 points to 1,710 points. Their handicap goes down to a H3. They will remain as a H3 until such point that their index goes above 1,800 (at which point they become a H2) or falls below 1,600 (when the become a H4 again).

Changes in handicap are calculated at the end of a tournament or match, and must be signed off on the green card by the tournament manager or match captain.
